# Current product portfolio.

## Innovations, modifications, discontinued models.

To make sure you're always up to date: In this section we would like to inform you about all the changes in our product portfolio. These include system expansions, modifications, planned discontinuations and other innovations, such as in the area of surfaces.

## Even more comfortable and elegant: heroal VS Z OR vertical awning

The heroal VS Z OR zip-guided sun protection system has been optimised: The cover box can be easily installed with the help of slot nuts, even if the eave profile is deflected. Installation is simplified because the guide rail has been decoupled from the motor bearing and roller capsule support. With the help of a drilling template, the motor bearing and roller capsule support can be positioned effortlessly. The end slat, which can be completely retracted into the cover box, ensures an attractive appearance; thanks to the adjustable front panel, the eaves, cover box and end slat have a uniform overall appearance.



## New optimised design: heroal GR 25 and heroal GR 37 FMB type II guide rail

We've redesigned the heroal GR 25 and heroal GR 37 FMB type II guide rails. As the powder and layer thickness had too strong an influence on the clip behaviour, a screwed version was developed:


This ensures a secure connection from the basic profile to the cover profile. The concealed screw fastening on the window or in the reveal simplifies installation considerably. The cover profile can be removed intuitively by loosening the screws. Anodising of the guide rails is possible without additional variants.





## Renewed and improved: heroal HS horizontal awning

The new guide rail and crossbar concept of heroal HS allows the installation of several systems placed side by side on one roof. Installation on "third-party roofs" is also possible. The strengthened end slat profile results in an improved fabric appearance. The upper panel has additional strengthenings to prevent any deflection. For one-piece installations, the maximum element area increases from 15 m² to 21 m². Integration of Somfy motors is possible. The new heroal HS guide rail will be available as part of the heroal Ready range of finished elements starting in April, and as a system product already in January 2023.



## 20% faster and more efficient: heroal D 72 PF EM door casement profile

Thanks to its optimised construction, the heroal D 72 PF EM door casement profile can save production steps and reduce workshop throughput times by up to 20% while using less material. The new insulating spacer geometry enables warp resistance without additional work steps. The reversible infill attachment makes infill installation guicker, easier and safer, as no prior machining of the profile is required for attachment. The casement profile with fixed inner stop does not require a glass strip, which makes processing particularly easy. The corner-vulcanised moulded corners connect the door end seal with the new fitting rebate insulation: This means that conventional sealing wedges do not have to be used. The sash profile behind the backstop eliminates the external shadow gap and there is no need to maintain gap sizes on the exterior. This can also be achieved on the inside by choosing the rebated casement. Thus, heroal D 72 PF EM features fewer work steps, less material usage and more efficiency.



## Only available until March 2023: heroal RS 54 roller shutter slat system

The market and its requirements are undergoing constant change: In the field of maxi roller shutter slats, heroal

will focus on its core products and phase out the heroal RS 54 roller shutter slat on 03/31/2023. Until then, the product will be available in the usual versions. Various alternatives are available as successors: The heroal RS 52 is particularly attractive in the new construction segment, but also in the renovation sector, thanks to its very wide colour spectrum and excellent wind load resistance. In addition, the heroal RS 55 SL allows very large element dimensions to be realised. We thus continue to offer you our usual strong, flexible and diverse system portfolio.



## New lengths available from stock: heroal FireXtech D 93 FP fire protection system

New lengths, less waste: Previously available in stock lengths of 6.0 m, the heroal FireXtech D 93 FP sash profiles are now available in lengths of 5.5 and 6.5 m. This significantly reduces waste. The remaining stock of sash profiles in the 6.0 m length can still be ordered. As with heroal D 82 FP, we also recommend our cutting service for heroal FireXtech D 93 FP. The adjustment of the profile lengths will be documented in the next edition of the ordering and manufacturing catalogue. The new lengths will be added to LogiKal in the next update. All profiles and lengths can also be found in the heroal FireXtech D 93 FP system overview in the heroal Communicator.

## New for easy installation: heroal WF EM window fitting

New to the heroal portfolio is the heroal WF EM window fitting system. Its best feature: It can be installed extremely quickly and easily. There is no need to cut the driving rods to length and punch them; the driving rods come in fixed lengths and are ready for installation. Furthermore, no free punching of the casement key corners is required; all building components can be installed frontally. heroal WF EM is ideal for upgrading: Only a few additional measures are required for RC 2. The extensive range ensures all common applications: The classic exposed hinge side heroal WF EM is available in various colours and handles casement weights of up to 130 kg. With the concealed heroal WF EM swing side. casements weighing up to 180 kg can be installed – for a clear, aesthetic window design. A range of accessories is also available, such as turn limiters and lock monitoring. The first items of the system – listed in the heroal WF EM ordering and manufacturing catalogue for download in the heroal Communicator – are already available to

In the meantime, we also offer further functions within this framework: The Athena program offers a complete



Construction projects are sometimes complex, resource-intensive and subject to high time pressure. Challenges that should already be addressed in the planning phase. Our Project Sales and Service team supports you right from the start.

#### 1. Project acquisition

The heroal Project Sales and Service team supports you as early as the order acquisition stage by arranging attractive projects and also offers architects and investors comprehensive advice on all tender requirements. In addition, you will find all planning-relevant information in our heroal Communicator specialist customer portal, always updated and independent of time and location. The "System search" tile provides you with an overview of the dimensions and properties of the corresponding system. In addition, test certificates, documents and object references can be accessed directly via the overview page. If you have any questions, our support team can be contacted by e-mail with a single click.





You can also use the word search on the heroal Communicator homepage to find system and planning manuals for our systems: These provide a detailed list of all technical properties, including surface coating, static values, heat transfer coefficients, test certificates and other certificates.

### 2. Quotation preparation

Preparing a quotation requires configuration, design and costing. Here, too, the effort can be reduced with digital solutions from heroal. In the Communicator, you'll find not only CAD but also BIM data containing the system sections. The search is very simple via the "BIM/CAD data" tile. In addition, the heroal Communicator offers planning tools for calculating sound reduction and U-values, among other things.

You can find all fitting information, including fitting instructions, in the heroal Communicator either via the search bar or via the "Documents" or "Processing instructions" tiles.

Of course, you can also obtain all product data in LogiKal, where the products can also be calculated and configured. A link between LogiKal and the heroal Communicator facilitates access to further digital services such as the search for processing/manufacturing instructions or the configuration and ordering of roller shutters and sun protection. For the best possible support, the current heroal database is also included in Athena. This allows you to solve even complex construction-related issues, such as wall attachments or insulation.

### 3 Implementation planning

The phase of implementation planning requires, among other things, the provision of evidence for the fulfilment of all requirements and constructability of the solutions offered. This can be done reliably on the basis of the planning in LogiKal, Athena and using the information on system and performance features, test certificates and system sections from the Communicator.

#### 4. Production planning

You've received the order: Now it's time for production and installation. You'll find all production instructions in the heroal Communicator under the tile "Processing instructions". Planning and maintenance instructions as well as CE markings can also be accessed there. In addition, installation videos are also available for various systems in the heroal media library in the Communicator. The integration of Communicator into LogiKal also allows processing instructions to be called up directly from LogiKal (see video "Settings in LogiKal").

To sum up, various services and digital solutions are already available today, geared towards providing you with the best possible support from order acquisition to successful project completion. We're already looking forward to working together on the next project and to jointly applying and further improving our range of solutions.

# Sun protection in cooperation.

## The heroal VS Z textile assembly in top-mounted box systems: an interview with Volker Klocke. Head of Product/Market Management.

Starting in early 2023, the heroal VS Z sun protection system can also be used in top-mounted boxes from various manufacturers. Why is textile sun protection currently in such demand?

With annual growth rates in the double-digit range, textile sun protection has developed very positively in recent years. The heroal VS Z zip screen system in particular is becoming more and more established on the market compared to external venetian blind and interior sun protection systems from other manufacturers.

This is in no small part due to the enormous advantages of the textile, external sun protection system, such as the optimum glare, privacy, heat and UV protection with optimal use of daylight, the high wind resistance of up to 145 km/h as well as the highest design freedom thanks to the extensive heroal textile portfolio. Sun protection systems also ensure a pleasant indoor climate, even on hot days, and save on cooling and heating costs, as the amount of heat entering the building can be regulated as required. This is why textile sun protection is also very much in demand in private housing, a market with a lot of potential. Here, top-mounted box systems made of PVC or special insulating material, known as "new building shutter boxes", are often used. Since we already have all the prerequisites on our side with the heroal VS Z textile group and the finished curtains in the roller shutter sector, a cooperation with manufacturers of these top-mounted box systems was an obvious choice.



## In which top-mounted box systems can heroal VS Z be integrated in the future?

The heroal VS Z sun protection system as a textile assembly is ideal for top-mounted boxes. Our heroal VS Z textile assembly consists of a finished fabric from the current heroal collection, a fabric shaft cut to size, an already installed motor from the heroal range of your choice and a pre-assembled end slat as well as all the necessary accessories. The system comes ready to install and can be put into operation immediately. With special bearing brackets, the finished system can then also be integrated into top-mounted boxes in the future. At the start of marketing, the integration of the heroal VS Z textile assembly in the Exte Elite XT and in the VEKA Variant 2.0 (PVC and EPS variants) is possible. In the long term, our goal is for our systems to be compatible with all common top-mounted box systems. With VEKA and Exte, we already cover a large part of the market. However, the possibility of further cooperation with other manufacturers is not excluded.

## To what extent do fabricators benefit from the cooperation?

Fabricators can use the existing Exte Elite XT and VEKA Variant 2.0 box systems (PVC and EPS variants) and the heroal VS Z textile assembly. Only a small number of new items are required for integration. The shaft bearing is moved forward in the direction of the curtain outlet by means of bearing plates or shells specially designed for the heroal VS Z sun protection system in order to ensure that the textile screen can run as vertically as possible into the guide rail. The guide rails have been newly developed by VEKA and Exte to ensure that they harmonise with the heroal VS Z as well as matching the respective guide rail platform of the manufacturers.

At the same time, we have added a new extended tubular motor and an additional end slat stop to our range. The heroal VS Z textile assembly is manufactured according to the order and is fully assembled for installation. The heroal VS Z textile assembly can be ordered in advance, allowing for a secure, fast and simple order process. An interface with another trade is not required.

### Which building components does the customer buy from heroal and which from Exte or VEKA?

All box components are supplied by Exte or VEKA as usual. The inner workings, i.e. the complete textile assembly including axle, textile, motor, end slat and accessory material, are supplied by heroal. The customer has the choice of guide rails: PVC guide rails or uncoated aluminium guide rails are ordered from VEKA or Exte. If coated Exte or VEKA aluminium quide rails are required, these can be purchased together with the textile assembly from heroal. As an alternative, a heroal GR 37 guide rail can be selected, which is available as a visibly mounted or flush-mounted variant. The aluminium rails are coated with the highly weatherresistant heroal hwr powder coating and are available in over 500 RAL and DB colour shades, the exclusive Les Couleurs® Le Corbusier and the heroal SD surface finish. This ensures that the end slat and guide rails always have the same colour shade and surface quality.

## Does heroal now also offer finished top-mounted box elements?

No. Our fabricators continue to assemble the boxes. In this respect, it is an advantage that we have a large common customer base with both VEKA and Exte.

#### Which drive variants are available?

We assume that the majority of textile sun protection systems will be equipped with motors. The motor mountings are designed for the motor heads of common manufacturers such as Somfy, elero or Selve – with different mountings for round and star head motors. In addition, there will also be crank-operated and battery-buffered drive solutions in case a secondary escape route is needed.



## Are there other shading systems from heroal that can be used in the top-mounted boxes?

In addition to the heroal VS Z textile assembly, finished roller shutter curtains from heroal in various versions can also be used in the top-mounted box systems. Our range of heroal finished curtains includes different rod and end slat variants in a wide range of colours. The use of heroal finished curtains in top-mounted boxes is already possible and will be further expanded in the coming years.

## What is the ordering process for heroal VS Z textile assemblies or heroal finished hangings for topmounted box systems?

The easiest and guickest way is to order online using the heroal Configurator. After entering the relevant order details such as box type, element dimensions, colour and drive type, the parts lists and cutting lengths for use of the assembly in the various top-mounted box systems are determined. Quotations can be generated directly from the heroal Configurator. They are automatically provided with your own company data if desired and can be supplemented with free items (e.g. assembly costs) if required. This makes order entry and the entire ordering process quick and easy, as orders can be placed directly online. The heroal Configurator can be called up at any time, even when on the move, via the heroal Communicator.



The past few years have been marked by several overlapping crises, both in the construction sector and in the global economy as a whole: Covid-19, disrupted supply chains, shortages in skilled employees, price increases in commodity and energy markets all this exacerbated by the Russia-

Ukraine war, inflation, rising interest rates and a clouded, uncertain investment climate that has already hit the construction sector particularly hard in certain areas. The heroal W 72 window system and heroal S 42 sliding door system were used.

The captain waves goodbye and steers the houseboat upstream along the Saar. The boat glides almost silently through the water. While the rest of the family stands at the railing and enjoys the scenic view, the photovoltaic system on the roof supplies 230 volts of electricity for the domestic technology in the houseboat. These "recreational captains" don't need a boating licence. In the headwaters of the Mettlach lock, they've rented one of the six Joylife Boats currently available to experience the Saar from the water.

The new, environmentally friendly boats offer not only nature-oriented recreation but also high-quality equipment and space for up to six people on a total of 54 m<sup>2</sup>. Among other things, the houseboats have a sleeping suite with a panoramic view, an 18 m<sup>2</sup> sun deck on the upper deck, a modern combined kitchen/living room including a washer-dryer, an on-board sewage treatment plant, stand-up paddleboards and their own e-scooters to explore the surroundings on land as well.

#### Light-flooded cabin with heroal window systems

Whoever thinks of a cabin - the living, sleeping and lounge areas of a ship - usually imagines narrow, dark rooms with small porthole windows that only allow a minimal glimmer of light to fall into the interior of the ship. The state-of-the-art Joylife Boats are guite different: They're designed like tiny houses on the water with the most generously proportioned glass surfaces

possible to provide the rooms with plenty of daylight. In addition, this gives the tenants the opportunity to see the surroundings at any time, even if it's storming or raining

The floor-to-ceiling aluminium windows from heroal, which are arranged on both sides of the ship, extend across the entire dining area and provide a view of the water and the shore landscapes from every seating position. The narrow frame profiles of the heroal W 72 window system ensure maximum transparency.

The sleeping suite is located towards the stern of the ship on the upper level and is accessible via a solid wooden staircase. The heroal windows are the highlight of the sleeping area. They are arranged over the entire wall surface on all three sides and provide a unique allround view. While the glass to the sides is fixed in the frame profiles, the middle window, also from the heroal W 72 window system, is designed as a hopper window so that it can be opened a crack inwards for ventilation from above without the casement impacting or taking up too much space. For more privacy, curtains are available that can be closed.

SBS Andernach GmbH specialises in sophisticated boat building and is responsible for the development, production and maintenance of the Joylife Boats. "We attached a lot of importance to generously sized glass surfaces and high-quality materials, so only aluminium windows came into question for us. With heroal, we have found a partner who offers us optimal solutions that are tailored exactly to us," explains Alex Friesen, Managing Director of SBS Andernach GmbH.

## heroal sliding door system fits in perfectly

A sliding door next to the steering wheel provides access to the roofed outdoor terrace of the houseboat. On the one hand, the sliding element must not block the captain's view during the journey and, on the other hand, the houseboat must be lockable when the tenants are on dry land. Thanks to its sophisticated construction, the filiaree heroal S 42 sliding door system meets these requirements and also stands out for its sustainability and economy.

As the houseboats can only be rented from April to November, the heroal S 42 sliding door system is ideal for areas that do not require any special heat insulation and where no large differences in temperature between inside and outside are to be expected. heroal sliding systems made of recycled aluminium are extremely durable and are also Cradle to Cradle Certified® (silver). This internationally recognised certification indicates the use of environmentally safe, healthy and recyclable materials. "We were particularly impressed by the sliding door from heroal," says Alex Friesen.



"The filigree profiles leave the view unobstructed, the sliding door blends in perfectly with the overall view and it always opens and closes smoothly and runs quietly in its track, even during intensive use. Thanks to the second sliding door at the rear, tenants can conveniently choose which way they want to go."



# Know-how: with the heroal TSC.

## Mechatronic door fittings on heroal fire doors.

Mechatronics, i.e. the synergetic interaction of mechanics and electronics, is also used in the door fittings of heroal fire doors. The connection of mechanical security elements and electronic building components allows you, for example, to regulate access control. The possibilities have developed considerably in recent years. In existing buildings in particular, it has become easier to implement a change of use without extensive wiring through the use of mechatronic fittings.

The opening and closing of fire doors is controlled by an electronic release authorisation. The release can be effected by means of proof of authorisation such as a card or a biometric code. The mechatronic door fittings included in the standard can be combined with locks according to EN 12209, EN 14846 or EN 15685. They can also be part of an emergency device according to EN 179, EN 125 or EN 3637.

As a rule, mechatronic access control units are batteryoperated and do not require conventional wiring. However, from the point of view of fire protection, standard or rechargeable batteries have a negative impact on the protective properties of the doors should they catch fire or explode. Due to the significant growth in the field of mechatronic locking technology, the German Institute for Building Technology ("Deutsches Institut für Bautechnik", DIBT) considers it necessary to



regulate the use of these fittings. Accordingly, only mechatronic fittings that are listed with their own approval on www.dibt.de are in conformity with the approval. These can be approved for the systems after testing or with evidence.

In response, heroal has checked the fittings that conform to the approval for use in our systems D 82 FP with the approval number Z-6.20-1920 and D 93 FP Z-6.20-2555. We have forwarded the fittings in question to the DIBT for approval. In future, these will be listed with the approvals in a separate accessories list. Please ensure that only building components that conform to the approval requirements are used on heroal fire doors. Talk to planners and architects in advance if building components that are not listed are put out to tender. In the existing approval extensions for heroal fire protection systems, you'll find the approved mechatronic hardware systems in the new Appendix 4 to the approval.
